Regional Representation

Each PSN consists of approximately 10-12 members, who reflect the cross-section of our target group as well as experience levels and geographical locations within the region. We encourage the involvement of people who have valuable links to networks in their local area or are willing to support and develop these links.

Responsibilities of the PSN

Whilst each PSN operates to best suit their needs, the primary purpose is to:

- Meet regularly face-to-face or via suitable medium
- Assist in linking PSCQ up with child care professionals
- Identify and prioritise professional support needs for the region
- Network with other services in the region
- Gather feedback from stakeholders
- Evaluate activities organised by the PSCQ
- Assist with the allocation of regional funding
- Nominate possible contractors.

Expectations of PSN members may include:

- Meeting (in person) 4 to 8 times per year.
- Being an active member of discussions & decision making
- Supporting and sustaining professional networks
- Assisting in 'hosting' professional support activities
- Participating in planning workshops
- Willingness to work as a team
